

Our Story

In the early 1980's a close-knit family, with a 15-year old daughter named Rose, made the brave move from York. They established a new and exciting language school in the heart of the bustling capital city, London. As citizens of the world, they had a dream to share the English language and English culture all around the world. Inspired by the talent and perseverance of their daughter, Rose, and the beauty, culture and tradition of York, they decided to combine these two concepts to form the name of the school – Rose of York. This combination in the heart of the multi-cultural city, that is London, has resulted in an exceptional language school that upholds British educational traditions.

THE YOUNG LEARNERS' PROGRAMME AIMS TO:



- **Generate an interest in, and understanding of, British culture through a variety of topics in a theme-based course connected to excursions and activities.**
- **Develop students' knowledge of vocabulary, grammar and functional language.**
- **Focus on communicating effectively in a variety of relevant and engaging situations.**
- **Help students develop teamwork, independent study, communication and the ability to make international friends. In addition to classroom study, the programme includes a wide variety of activities such as games, competitions and day trips. Students will not only learn the language but also become more familiar with British culture through exploring places of interest in London and the surrounding areas.**

ACCOMMODATION

FULL-BOARD RESIDENCE

Your child will stay in a safe and secure residence accommodation, with 24-hour security and staff with many years of experience in welcoming young students and who have also passed strict safeguarding checks, including the Children's Barred List and an Enhanced DBS (criminal record check). Residence accommodation is situated in Zone 1, Zone 2 or Zone 3. Zone 3 is a quieter zone around London with excellent transport links to the city centre and to the school.

Students under 16 must stay in suitable residence accommodation on a full-board meal plan (with breakfast, dinner and a packed lunch provided by the residence every day). Your child will be offered a choice of nutritious food at each mealtime. Each meal will include a selection of hot and cold dishes including fresh fruit and vegetables.

Students aged 14-15 are allowed to travel to school by themselves and leave the residence unsupervised at weekends, subject to parental/guardian consent. A responsible adult will always be available to the students should they need it.

Students aged 12-13 are never left unsupervised and they must be escorted to and from school by their group leader.

WELFARE

Your child's welfare is our top priority. Your child will be cared for by our dedicated support team, which includes host parents (if staying at a homestay accommodation), teachers and activity leaders 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

All Rose of York staff must pass strict safeguarding checks, including the Children's Barred List and an Enhanced DBS (criminal record check). All staff have completed a course in Safeguarding and the welfare staff caring for your children also hold the Advanced Safeguarding Certificate.

A member of our team will meet your child in the arrivals hall at the airport and will accompany them to their homestay. On departure, your child is escorted to the check-in desk for their flight back home.

Students under 14 will always be accompanied on their way to and from school and will be supervised 24 hours a day. Students that are 14 or over are supervised at school and at home but are allowed to travel on their own to and from school with their parents' consent.
