
ROSE OF YORK LONDON LANGUAGE SCHOOL

As citizens of the world, they had a dream to share the English language and English culture all around the world. Inspired by the talent and perseverance of their daughter, Rose, and the beauty, culture and tradition of York, they decided to combine these two concepts to form the name of the school – Rose of York. This combination in the heart of the multi-cultural city, that is London, has resulted in an exceptional language school that upholds British educational traditions.

ACCOMMODATION

HOMESTAY IN THE HEART OF LONDON

All our homestays are chosen for their commitment to ensuring that the student feels at home. They are kind and caring and some of them have been hosting Rose of York students for many years. This means that we know them well and we trust them to look after our students and provide them with the personal touch by living in a comfortable home.

Our homestays are regularly inspected to British Council and English UK standards and add a little something extra to your time in London.

All Rose of York homestays:

- Help students to feel at home and treat them as a member of the family
- Encourage students to speak English as much as possible
- Provide a clean and comfortable room and a suitable environment for studying
- Offer students a healthy and balanced diet

At Rose of York we do not place students of the same nationality in the same homestay (unless specifically requested by students).



ACCOMMODATION


FULL-BOARD HOMESTAY

Your child will stay in safe and secure homestay accommodation, with host families that have years of experience in welcoming young students and who have also passed strict safeguarding checks, including the Children's Barred List and an Enhanced DBS (criminal record check). Your child will be offered a choice of nutritious food at each mealtime; breakfast, lunch and dinner. Every meal includes a selection of hot and cold items including fresh fruit and vegetables. Homestay accommodation is situated in Zone 3 and Zone 4. Zone 3 and Zone 4 are quieter zones around London with excellent transport links to the city centre and to school. Homestays in these zones are usually more spacious and all homestay hosts provide students with their own bedroom, and private or shared bathroom facilities.

Students under 16 must stay in suitable homestay accommodation on a full-board meal plan (with breakfast, dinner and a packed lunch provided by the homestay every day). Students aged 12–13 are never left unsupervised. They must be escorted to and from school. In this case, please note that there are extra obligatory expenses: ASSISTED TRAVEL TO/FROM SCHOOL 6 DAYS A WEEK (£150). Students aged 14–15 are allowed to travel to school by themselves and leave the homestay unsupervised at weekends, subject to parental/guardian consent. Please note that students under 16 will not get a key. A responsible adult will be at home to allow students unrestricted access to the house.

All students under 16 must return to their homestay for dinner. They are not allowed to leave the homestay after dinner.

All homestay hosts accommodating students under 18 undergo criminal record checks and the main host has an enhanced DBS check.



WELFARE

Your child's welfare is our top priority. Your child will be cared for by our dedicated support team, which includes host parents (if staying at a homestay accommodation), teachers and activity leaders 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

All Rose of York staff must pass strict safeguarding checks, including the Children's Barred List and an Enhanced DBS (criminal record check). All staff have completed a course in Safeguarding and the welfare staff caring for your children also hold the Advanced Safeguarding Certificate.

A member of our team will meet your child in the arrivals hall at the airport and will accompany them to their homestay. On departure, your child is escorted to the check-in desk for their flight back home.

Students under 14 will always be accompanied on their way to and from school and will be supervised 24 hours a day. Students that are 14 or over are supervised at school and at home but are allowed to travel on their own to and from school with their parents' consent.
